Activities of AASRA

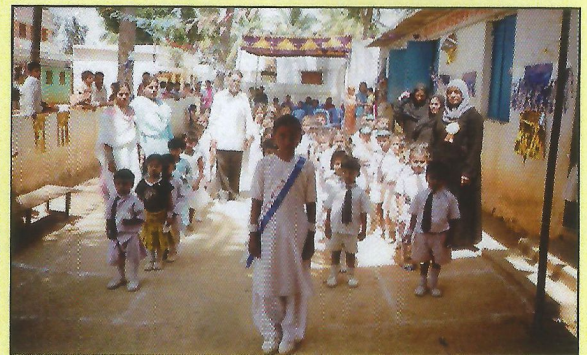
1. Counseling Center & Women's Helpline

AASRA Helpline is a 24/7 service that assists women in need. It provides support to them to face urgent issues without any reservation. Each case is handled after detailed analysis by experts and trained counsellors followed by appropriate suggestions and solutions that help solve their problems. AASRA has supported many women overcome their personal and family problems like - Domestic Violence, Dowry Harassment, Divorce, Desertion and Abandonment. Many women and children have taken refuge in its home which provides free food and accommodation. A short safe stay is ensured for the needy at the home which is open for all deprived.



2. Al-Quds Nursery and Primary School

To mould our future generation in the righteous path Al-Quds School was established. The school recognized by the Government of Karnataka follows the approved State Curriculum with a fine blend of moral values so essential for the growth and development of children. Priority is given to the underprivileged children who are denied admissions in other educational institutions due to lack of funds. AASRA manages and supports the school and the children's requirements by providing many additional facilities. Al-Quds School has benefitted many children and families over the years.



3. Scholarship Programs for Orphans and Physically Challenged Students

With an aim of encouraging and supporting further education of deserving orphans and physically challenged students AASRA provides Educational Scholarships. Over the years this effort has been very successful and well-appreciated. The scholarship has motivated and facilitated many students to continue their education thereby giving them the confidence to reach higher goals.



4. Monthly Distribution of Groceries to Widows AASRA has taken up the cause to distribute groceries and food requirements to the poor and the widows every month. Along with food clothing is also provided to the poor families in the month of Ramadan. Many underprivileged seek this assistance from us every month and this number is growing everyday.



5. Awareness Programs for Women and Children

AASRA conducts regular awareness programs for women and children on social, economic and health related issues to build a better society. In addition AASRA conducts campaigns and awareness drives to highlight the issue of violence against women and children. The social activists of AASRA march hand in hand with other Organisations and NGO's of the city to give due rights to the oppressed.



6. Free Medical Camps

AASRA organizes free medical camps for the sick and diseased in many locations providing medication and medical advice from professional Doctors. Financial assistance is also provided for medical treatment and hospitalization.
